There will be food, drink and music throughout the day at our beautiful waterfront setting.

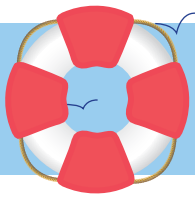

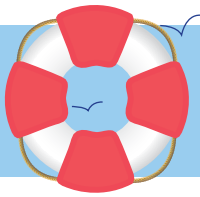
