After a tragic accident on the water in 2012, our organization stepped up to protect the safety of our membership and all regional boaters by lobbying state law makers to make boater education mandatory statewide. This was not easily accomplished as there was much push-back from special interest groups. We forged on and presented the first ever Huntington Safe Boating Week to educate members, friends and families throughout our region.

A week of cost-free classes and events has been offered each year since 2012, along with an outstanding Waterfront Festival with live music and crafts for everyone to enjoy.

COVID 19 interrupted our schedule for the last three years but we continued to present free classes. We are announcing the return of the Waterfront Festival and our popular Meet the Commodores Event for 2023.

We rely on the cooperation of the Town of Huntington, Coast Guard Auxiliary and Power Squadron to assist in this remarkable and highly successful week. Many hundreds of new and experienced boaters have been educated since Safe Boating Week began.




